Renewals for 2018 are starting to come in strong. We now sit at 72% renewals for 2018. Keep in mind that renewing is easy and can be done on-line. It helps the Post save time as your renewal goes straight to Department and National. Those of you that remain, please help us save some money and renew online at www.legion.org/renew or send your dues to the Post. It only takes a minute. One more item, the new cards show more information. Several members are missing service and/or periods served. Please take credit for your service. Any member with 50+ years of membership will have their dues paid by the Post. Please ensure that a copy of your DD-214 is on file with the Post. If you can't locate it, contact the Post and we can get the paperwork started so that you can receive your copy. It will come in handy to verify your service. All veterans with honorable or general discharges will be eligible to shop online at the various service exchanges starting this month on Veteran's Day. You can verify your status on www.vetverify.org http://www.vetverify.org/. If you haven't tried it yet, consider checking it out. Remember, our organization can only survive with active members. If you know any veteran that may be interested, please contact any officer for an application. This could be your chance to win \$1000 for referring an eligible member. A new member is any eligible veteran joining for the 2018 membership year who is not a member in 2017. Five members will have a chance by referring a name into the drawing. To enter, print and mail in the form fromwww.legion.org/documents/legion/pdf/newcertification_referral_form.pdf. The cutoff date is May 9, 2018. A certificate of appreciation will be mailed to the member responsible for the referral. Our next meeting is Thursday, December 21, 2017 at 1830. Please come to the meeting, voice your concerns and find out what's happening both in this Post and the Legion. Pursuant to RSA 261-C, the NH DMV is issuing Veteran Decal Plates.
