ADJUTANT'S MESSAGE

The message from Department is keep increasing membership. Any veteran that you know that is not a member could be invited to join by you. Talk this up and bring them in for a visit.

IMPORTANT Since 1957, Social Security taxes were paid on military earnings. Since 1988, inactive duty pay has also been covered by Social Security. Under certain circumstances extra earnings for your military service from 1957 through 2001 can be credited to your record for Social Security purposes. You may qualify for increased amounts of your benefit. Special extra earnings credits are granted for periods of active duty or active duty for training only. Military service from 1957 through 1967, SSA will add the extra credits to your record when you apply for benefits. Military service from 1968 through 2001, you don't need to do anything, these credits were automatically added to your record. After 2001, there are no special extra credits for military service. The credit amounts are: Service 1957 through 1977 is \$300 for each calendar you received active duty basic pay. Service 1978 through 2001, for every

\$300 in active duty base pay, you are credited with an additional \$100 up to \$100 per year. Check with Social Security for details.

Membership renewals for 2019 are coming in strong. Please keep them coming as Early Bird ends on October 15th. We are still accepting 2018 renewals. So, if you haven't renewed yet, please get them in as soon as possible. The deadline is fast approaching. Please renew online or send your dues to the Post. It only takes a minute. As I have been writing all year, please renew on line at www.legion.org. You will get your membership card much quicker. We have been having some issues with member home addresses. Remember, it is your responsibility to keep your address current, especially if you are paid up for life (PUFL). You can update your address on www.legion.org. Our organization can only survive with active members. If you know any veteran that may be interested, please contact any officer for an application. Our next meeting is September 20th at 1830. Please come to the meeting, voice your concerns and find out what's happening both in this Post and the Legion. Come out and find out about your post.
